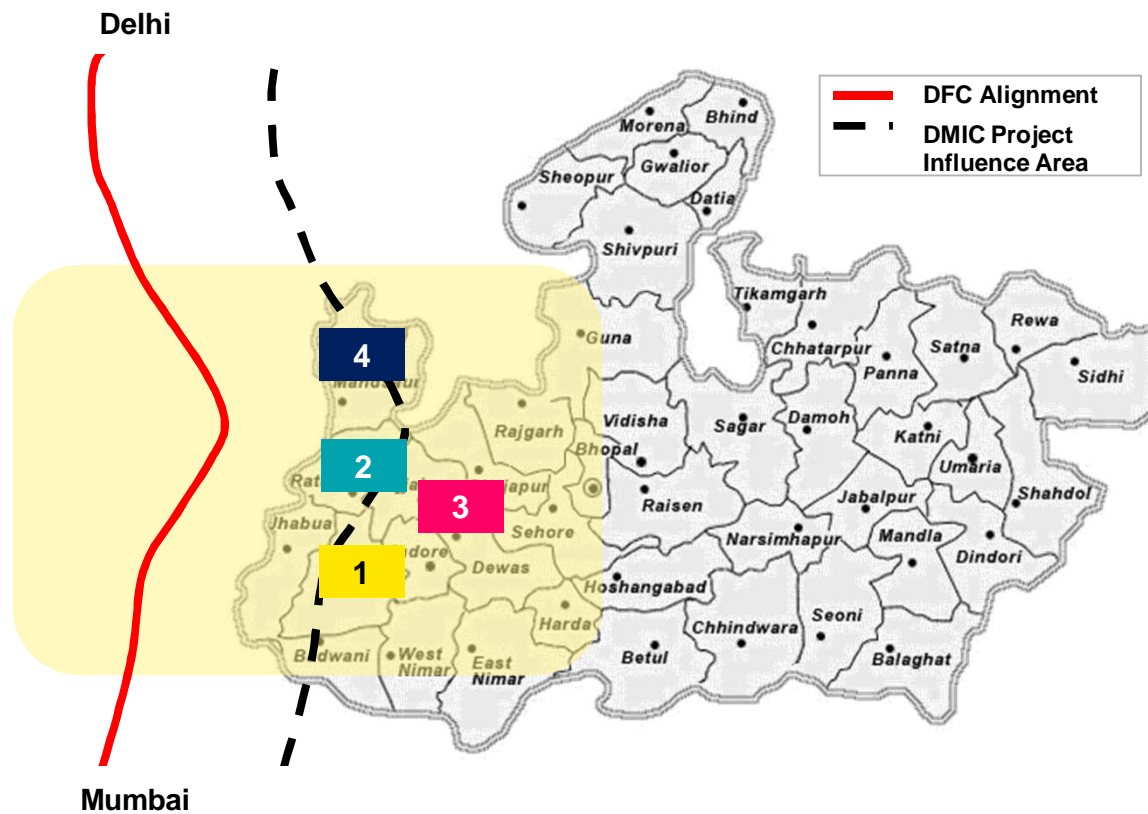


DMIC – Madhya Pradesh

- Economic Corridor from Indore Airport to Pithampur Industrial growth center

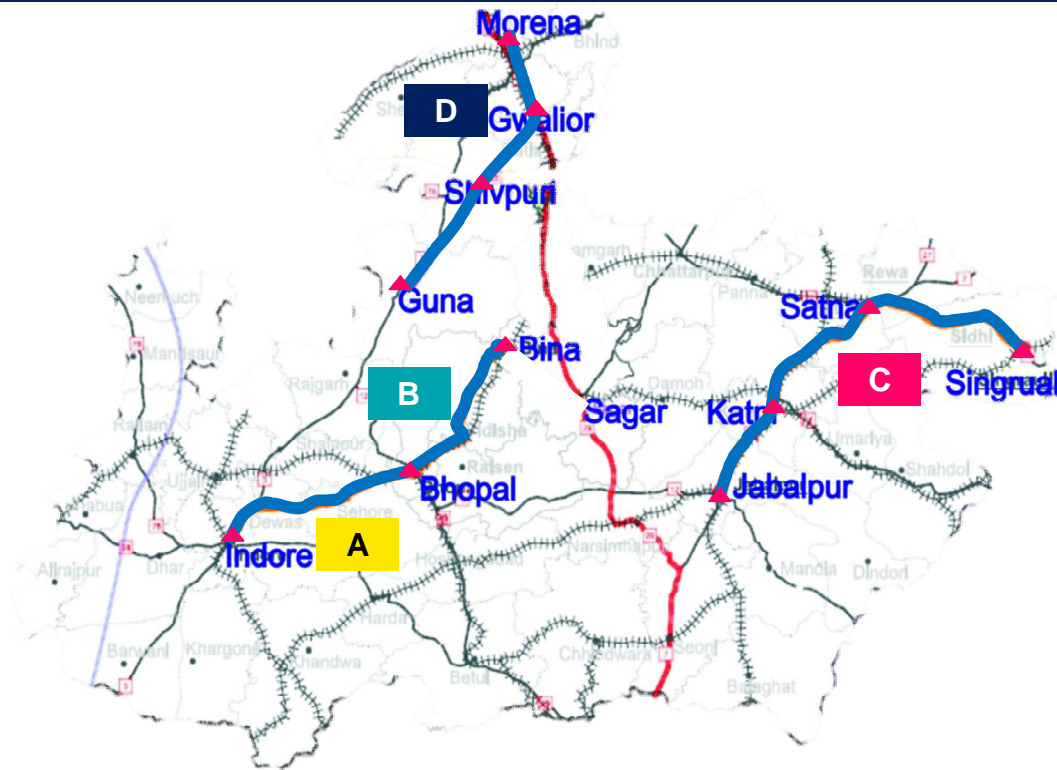
State Investment Corridors
